| 1. | Why is Paul brought before the Sanhedrin (23:1-5)? Why is the Tribune in attendance? Is his presence necessary?   |
| 2. | What is God's part in this event (v. 11)?   |
| 3. | To what lengths are the Jewish fanatics willing to go in order to silence Paul, and how committed are they (vv. 11-15)? What divine and human factors stop the fanatics (vv. 16-30)?  |
| 4. | What is your impression of Claudius Lysias as he responds to this threat on Paul's life (vv. 23-25)?  |
| 5. | There are four major human parties in the events of this chapter: Paul, the Sanhedrin, the conspirators, Claudius Lysias. Discuss the level of commitment to their beliefs and how they acted on them. Where do you see these types of commitment today?    |

6. How did Paul refute the charges which Tertullus makes against him (24:2-21)? (Specifically, note that Paul is charged (a) with making trouble, inciting dissension (vv. 11-13, 17-18); (b) with leading a new, unlawful sect (vv. 14-16); and (c) with desecrating the Temple (vv. 11-13,17,21).)
7. Why is it important to us that Christianity was not something new, but the true extension of the faith recorded in the Law and the prophets (vv. 14-15)?
8. Felix is typical of the person who is exposed to, but ultimately rejects the Gospel (vv. 22-27). What forces are active in Felix's life and in his relationship with Paul? Why doesn't he become a convert?
9. To this point, how long has Paul been in protective custody (v. 27)? What do you think he was doing all this time? What would you have done?
